Abstract -

Vamana Karma, also known as "medical emesis" or "medical vomiting", is one of the five Procedures of *Panchakarma* which is used in of disorders. treatment Kaphaj Panchakarma procedure is the most essential part of Ayurveda treatments. In Ayurved, diseases of Ear, Nose, Throat & Head And Eye with their Management are studied in Branch Which is Called as Shalakya Tantra.

Now a days Shalakya (ENT & Ophthalmic) Diseases Major Concerned Because patient does not want to go for surgical procedure. Looking towards Ayurved, there are lot of Panchakarma Procedures Advocated for Shalakya (ENT & Ophthalmic) disorders. Among this Panchakarma Procedure Vaman Karma (medical emesis) is the Primary Procedure.

Key Words- Vaman procedure/ Karma, Panchakarma, Shalakya Tantra, Medical emesis or Vomiting, Kaphaj disorders, Ayurvedic Management for ENT & Ophthalmic Diseases, URTI.

Vamana Karma, also known as medical emesis or medical vomiting, is one of the five principle procedure of *Panchakarma* which used management of Kaphaj disorders. Panchakarma is the most essential part of Ayurveda treatments. It is preventive, preservative, promotive, curative and rehabilitative therapy. Vaman Procedure is to eliminate vitiated Kapha Dosha (URTI) which in turn helps to prevent the forth coming Kapha disorders associated *Pitta* disorders (Hyperacidity) or diseases originating or settled in the place of Kapha like bronchial asthma,

allergic bronchitis, rhinitis, sinusitis, migraine, GERD, Migraine etc.In Ayurved diseases of Ear, Nose,Throat & Head And Eye And Their Treatment are studied in Branch Which is Called as *Shalakya Tantra*.

Now a days ENT & Ophthalmic Diseases Are Major Concerned Because patient could not want to go for surgical procedure. Looking towards *Ayurved* there are lot of *Panchakarma* Procedures Advocated for this disorders. Among this *Panchakarma* Procedure *Vaman Karma* is the Primary Procedure.

Vaman Karma is also a prime treatment procedures for various Diseases which are related to Shalakya Tantra (Ear, Nose, Throat & Head And Ophthalmology). All the three Acharya Of Ayurved namely Charaka, Sushruta And Vaghabhata have been Explained **Importance** of Vaman karma Concerned diseases of Shalakya Tantra (Ear, Nose, Throat & Head And Ophthalmology).

Vaman karma in Shalakya Tantra
Can be described under the Following
headings:

- a) Vaman Karma in Karna Roga(Diseases of Ear)
- b) Vaman Karma in Nasa Roga (Diseases of Nose)

- c) Vaman Karma in Mukh Roga
 (Diseases of Oral Cavity)
- d) Vaman Karma in Shiro Roga
 (Diseases of Head)
- e) Vaman Karma in Netra Roga (Diseases of Eye)

A) Vaman Karma in Karna Roga (Diseases of Ear): -

1) Sushrutachrya has described the indication of Vaman Karma in the "UttarSthan Chapter 21 KarnagatrogPratishedhiya" and out of 28 Diseases indicated for "KrumiKarna" And "KarnaKandu". (Ref Su U 21/53-53 & 21/56)

The Ear diseases indicated for *Vaman Karma* are:

- 1. KrumiKarna (Otomycosis)
- 2. *KarnaKandu* (Seborrheic dermatitis in ear)
- 3. *KaphajKarnashool* (Ear ache)
- 4. *KarnaNaad* (Tinnitus)

- 5. *KarnaBadhirya* (Hearing Loss)
- 6. *KarnaVidhradi* (Ear Abscess)

- KaphajPratishyaya (Allergic Rhinitis)
- 6. Pinas (Atropic Rhinitis)
- 7. PutiNasa (Fungal Rhinosinusitis)
- 8. *NasaRoga Samanya* (Diseases of Nose)

C) Vaman Karma in Mukh Roga (Diseases of Oral Cavity): -

- 2. Balasgratith (Cyst of Conjunctiva/ Chemosis)
- 3. LekhyaRogaSamanya (Procedure of Scraping)
- 4. Kaphoklishta Vartma (Oedema of eyelid /Acute purulent Conjunctivitis)
- 5. PakshmaShaat (Madarosis)
- 6. Kukunaka (Ophthalmia Neonatorum)



Conclusion: -

Panchakarma is the most essential treatments of diseases of Ear, Nose, Throat & Head And Eye. Indicted Vaman Karma is for Urdhvajatrugat Roga (Ear, Nose, Throat & Head And Eye Diseases). As per Basic principal of Ayurvedic Treatment Before giving treatment for Disease; any purification of body is necessary. According to Ayurved Accumulation of Dosh is happen in Koshtha (Abdomen); so to remove disease from its root or for management of a chronic diseases and to Avoid its recurrence we should do Panchakarma Procedure.

Vaman Karma helps to pull out dosha from Koshtha (Abdomen).

According to Ayurved literature Diseases of Shalakya Tantra is having Kapha Dosha Dominance. Primary Treatment for Any diseases having kapha dosha Vaman dominance is Karma.It preservative, preventive, promotive, curative and rehabilitative therapy

So it is Concluded that before going to treat (Before Aushadhi Chikitsa) above said diseases of Shalakya tantra once should do Vaman Karma with respective usefull Vaman dravya (Drugs used for Emesis)
