#### Abstract

Rasashastra and Bhaishajya kalpana is the branch of Ayurveda, deals with the preparation of Ayurvedic medicines using various herbal and herbo-mineral drugs. Rasashastra deals with minerals, metallic medicines and Bhaishajyakalpana includes herbal medicines. Kaphakuthar Rasa is a Kharaliya Rasayan. A Kharaliya Rasayan is prepared in kharal (Mortar and pestle) and triturated under pressure which allows the sustained release of active molecules. This type is the most widely used, has prolonged shelf life, can be transformed in the form of vati (tablets, pills) etc. Kaphakuthar Rasa is a herbo-mineral formulation mentioned in texts of Rasashastra. Kaphakuthar Rasa is commonly indicated in Kasa Vyadhi. Kasa is such diseases in which we observe chronic condition (Jirna avastha). Variation is observed in preparation of this formulation.

#### **Introduction:**

Avurveda is an ancient science of life and is superior than other medical sciences. In today's era and competitive world there has been a negative impact on eating habit and lifestyle. Because of that we are exposed to various types of diseases. Nowadays our diet has become more synthetic and artificial than the natural one. Which gives us various disorders and diseases. Kasa is not only mentioned as a symptom in various diseases but also it is an independent Vyadhi with its pathogenesis, signs and symptoms, types and treatment. If we don't treat kasa vvadhi in primary stage it can give rise to life threatening diseases like Shwasa, Urakshata, Arbuda in respiratory tract, Shosha, Rajyakshma, Raktapitta, Granthi etc. Prana is the most important in vayu and is related with life, therefore any abnormality leads to disturbance of all the functions as Prana is sarvagata. 'Kasa' is one of the primary diseases of Pranavaha strotosa, if not treated can affect 'Sarvagat Prana'.

*Rasashastra* deals with the use of minerals and herbs together for the preparation of various medicinal formulations. Based on the difference in the preparation method, all *Rasa Aushadhi* are classified into 4 types: 1. *Kharaliya Rasayan* 2. *Parpati Rasayan* 3. *Kupipakwa Rasayan* 4. *Pottali Rasayan* 

A *Kharaliya Rasayan* is prepared in *kharal* (Mortar and pestle) and triturated under pressure which allows the sustained release of active molecules. This type is the most widely used, has prolonged shelf life, can be transformed in the form of *vati* (tablets, pills) etc. *Kaphakuthar Ras* is a *Kharaliya Rasayan* indicated in *Kaphaj kasa* (Chronic cough).

Dhatuksheenata, Vegopdharana, Raja, Ruksha anna, Vayu vimargagamana, Vidahi-Guru-Vishtambhi anna, Amladosha, Shita gunatmak ahara-vihara. Abhighata, Ashamashayana general are various etiological factors of Kasa. Because of etiological factors Vayu gets vitiated. Vitiated Apana vayu pushes Udana vayu upwards. Udana vayu reverts normal Gati of results Prana in Kasa. Vamana, kavalgraha, katu ruksha ushna ahar, Nasya, Dhuma, Ushna leha and Kaphaghna drugs are advised for management of Kaphaja Kasa. this study is an attempt to go through references of KaphakutharRasa formulations in literature in order to have better understanding of these formulations in terms of their

composition, indications and contribution of various texts regarding this drug.

#### Aim:

The aim of the study is to compile all available references of *Kaphakuthar Rasa* available in texts and to study them in comparative manner in terms of their composition, method of preparation, dose, indications and contribution of various ayurvedic texts regarding this particular formulation.

#### Materials and methods

concluded that it can be used *in jirna avstha* of *Kaphaj Kasa* and *Jwara*.
